

GAME LEADERS:

21. Each team must have available a Game Leader for each match. The Game Leader must be prepared to assume responsibility for leading the game if required.

SIDELINES:

22. Each team will have a vested Marshal, who will manage team supporters and spectators as per main round games.
23. This Gala Day is meant to be a **fun, non-competitive event for children**. Any adult who displays inappropriate behaviour towards children or match officials or directs aggressive behaviour towards other spectators or officials will be asked to immediately remove themselves from the sideline. If you don't believe your spectators, parents or team officials can manage this requirement.

FINE PRINT:

24. Clubs must submit teams and nominate players via Dribl. Separate instructions which will be sent to club administrators
25. . Each team must have a registered coach and a registered manager. These officials are responsible for completing match sheets on the day.
26. Clubs may nominate multiple teams. However, second and subsequent teams will only be considered after each club has had at least one team in the relevant age group allocated to the Gala Day, subject to nomination closing dates.
27. Allocation of second and subsequent teams will be determined by a random draw.
28. Clubs who do not nominate their first team by the close off date will be included in the random draw alongside all second teams.
29. .
30. Match fixtures will be randomly generated using Dribl. No requests or objections regarding the draw will be considered.
31. Clubs who fails to nominate their players or withdraws a team after the **Thursday 25th June 2026** will incur a \$50 withdrawal fine.
32. To avoid this fee, a withdrawing team may be replaced by another team from the same age group.
33. Any teams that fails to attend (no show) on the Gala Day, will incur a \$100 forfeit penalty for their club.

INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATION: PRINT:

34. Information and instructions regarding match day requirements and marshalling will be available on the NFA website once the final roster of teams has been established, and information will be posted via our socials the week prior to the Gala Day.
35. Team Officials who have questions about this Gala Day should direct them to their club admins, who in turn will communicate with Nepean FA. Please respect this chain of command protocol in the period leading up to the Gala Day.
